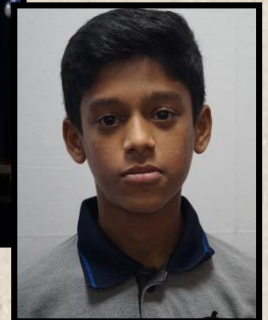


**“TALENT WINS GAMES, BUT TEAMWORK AND INTELLIGENCE

"IN A WORLD WHERE YOU CAN BE ANYTHING, BE KIND."

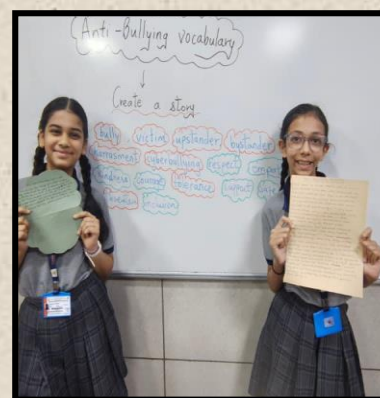

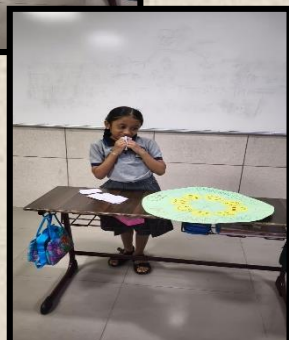
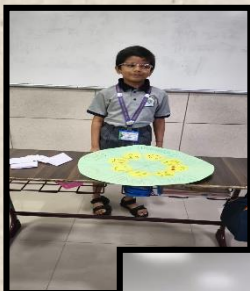

"खरे स्वातंत्र्य तेच, जेव्हा एखादा देश स्वतःच्या पायावर उभा राहतो — हाच आत्मनिर्भर भारताचा खरा आत्मा आहे"

“विद्यार्थ्यांनी ‘आत्मनिर्भर भारत’ या विषयावरील निबंधलेखन स्पर्धेत उत्साहाने सहभाग घेतला. स्वावलंबन, नवीन संधी, रोजगारनिर्मिती आणि देशाच्या प्रगतीत योगदान या महत्त्वपूर्ण कल्पना त्यांच्या लिखाणातून उजागर झाल्या. या उपक्रमामुळे विद्यार्थ्यांमध्ये राष्ट्राभिमान, जबाबदारीची जाणीव आणि सृजनशीलता अधिक बळकट झाली.”

आत्मनिर्भर भारत

“इतिहासाच्या सुरुवातीस भारताने त्याची अजरामर शोधायात्रा आरंभ केली आणि अमर्याद शतकांमध्ये त्याचे प्रयत्न, यश आणि अपयश यांची भव्यता भरलेली आहे. चांगल्या आणि वाईट काळातसुद्धा तो कधीही ती शोधायात्रा विसरला नाही किंवा ते आदर्श विसरला नाही, जे त्याला बळ देत होते.” पंडित नेहरू यांच्या या प्रेरणादायी विचारांनी मी त्या भावनेने सुरू करते जी आपल्या घटनासम्रेने ७६ वर्षांपूर्वी उभारली — जेव्हा त्यांनी भारताच्या स्वातंत्र्यानंतर जगातील सर्वात मोठ्या लोकशाहीचा पाया रचला. या निमित्ताने, आपल्या देशाच्या अद्वितीय वाटचालीकडे नजर टाकूया.

विविध क्षेत्रांमध्ये भारताने लक्षणीय प्रगती केली आहे. आपल्या सीमा सुरक्षित करायला प्रतिभावान वैज्ञानिकांनी अग्नी आणि ब्रह्मोस क्षेपणास्त्र तयार केले. आपल्या शूरवीर नव्हे तर दोन शूरवीरांनांनी भारताचे ‘ऑपरेशन सिंदूर’ अचूक पार पाडले. अंतराळ क्षेत्रातसुद्धा आपण एक मोठे पाऊल उचलले आहे — आदित्य एन १ द्वारे सूर्याच्या निरीक्षणासाठी आपली पहिलीच मोहीम, जी आज गर्वाने आकाशात प्रवास करत आहे. आर्थिकदृष्ट्या भारत आज जगातील पाचवी सर्वात मोठी अर्थव्यवस्था बनला आहे. ‘आत्मनिर्भर भारत’ व ‘मेक इन इंडिया’ या उपक्रमांमुळे आपण योग्य दिशेने वाटचाल करत आहोत. सामाजिक क्षेत्रात ‘प्रधान मंत्री विकास योजना’ व ‘आयुष्मान भारत’ सारख्या योजनांनी गरजूंचे आरोग्य सुरक्षा कवच तयार केले आहे. क्रीडा क्षेत्रात नट्य सेन, गुकेश, मनु भाकर यांच्या सारख्या असंख्य खेळाडूंनी आणि शुभांशु शुक्ला सारख्या अंतराळयात्रींनी भारताच्या

कानाकोपऱ्यातून उभं राहत जागतिक पातळीवर यश मिळवले आहे.

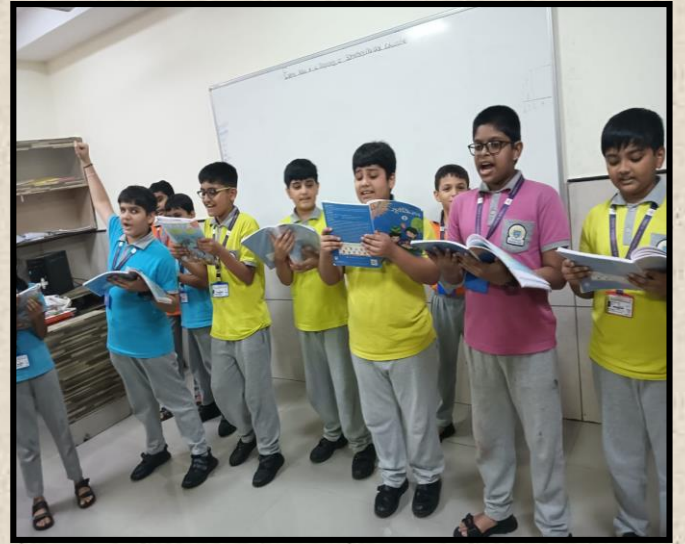
आपल्या देशाची वाटचाल सहज शक्य झाली नाही. ते शक्य झाले फक्त त्या स्वातंत्र्यसंग्रामात आपले रक्त, घाम आणि प्राण अर्पण करणाऱ्या क्रांतीकारकांमुळे. या सोबतच हे विसरता कामा नये की आजही या प्रवासात अनेक अडथळे आहेत. बेरोजगारी, शिक्षण आणि आरोग्य सुविधांची कमतरता ही आजच्या भारताची मुख्य समस्या आहेत. जगातील सर्वात मोठे सरकारी आरोग्य अभियान असलेल्या भारतात आजही काही लोक स्वच्छ पाण्यासाठी तडकडतात. भ्रष्टाचार, पर्यायवरण न्हास, महिला अत्याचार, जातीयवाद व वाढती लोकसंख्या या गंभीर समस्या आहेत.

सुभाषचंद्र बोस यांच्या शब्दात, “स्वातंत्र्य दिलं जात नाही, ते मिळवावं लागतं.” आपण आपल्याला कष्टांनी मिळालेलं हे स्वातंत्र्य गमवूया नको. देशाच्या तरुणांना सक्षम करणं गरजेचं आहे कारण त्यांचं ज्ञान, त्यांची ऊर्जा, सर्जनशीलता आणि जिद्द हेच भारताचं भविष्य ठरवतील. केवळ साक्षर्यातून मुक्त होणे स्वातंत्र्य नव्हे, तर विचारांनी मुक्त होणे हे खरे स्वातंत्र्य आहे आणि त्या दिवशी माझा भारत खऱ्या अर्थाने आत्मनिर्भर होईल.

गायन विधि तथा स्पष्टीकरण

कोशिश करने वालों की हार नहीं होती" कविता के स्पष्टीकरण और गायन से छात्रों को निम्नलिखित फायदे हैं। आत्मविश्वास में वृद्धि: कविता का संदेश छात्रों में आत्मविश्वास और सकारात्मक सोच को बढ़ावा देता है। प्रेरणा और उत्साह: कविता छात्रों को अपने लक्ष्यों की प्राप्ति के लिए प्रयास करने और हार नहीं मानने के लिए प्रेरित करती है। भावनात्मक समझ: कविता के माध्यम से छात्रों को भावनात्मक समझ और सहानुभूति की क्षमता विकसित होती है। यह गतिविधि छात्रों की अध्ययन-अध्यापन की प्रक्रिया को सुलभ तथा रोचक बनाने में प्रभावशाली साबित हुई।
