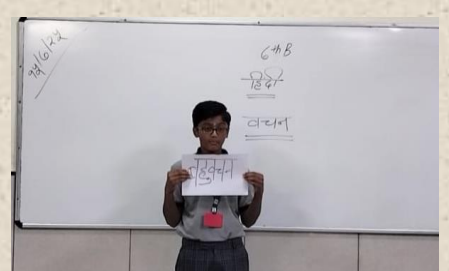
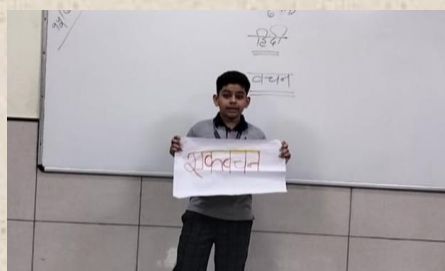
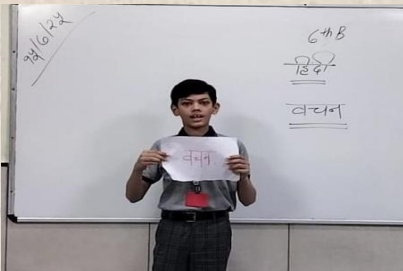
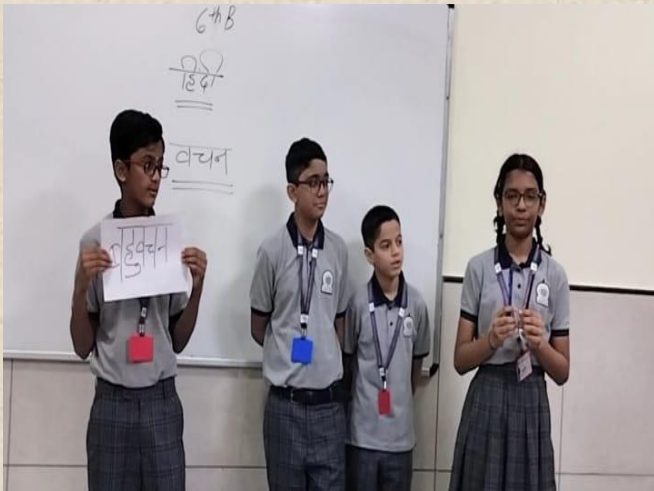


# सरल वाणी

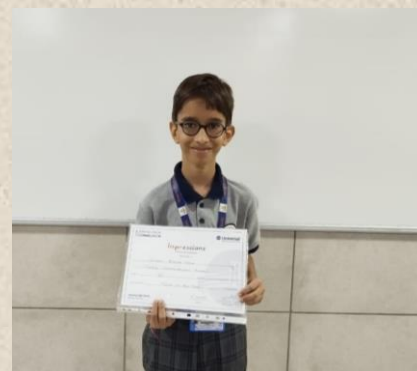

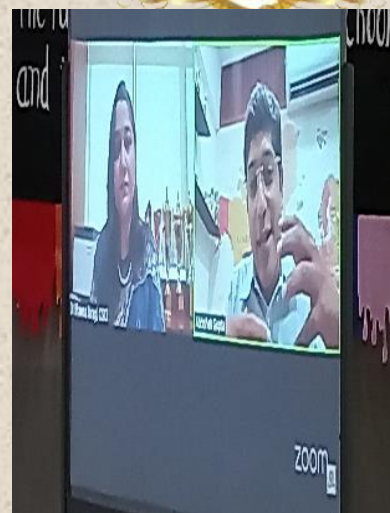
## ONLINE CAREER COUNSELLING SESSION
