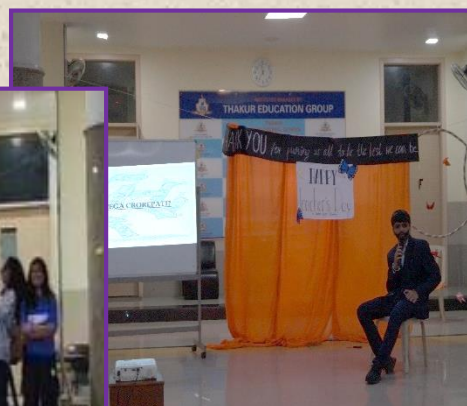




# Teacher's Day Celebration

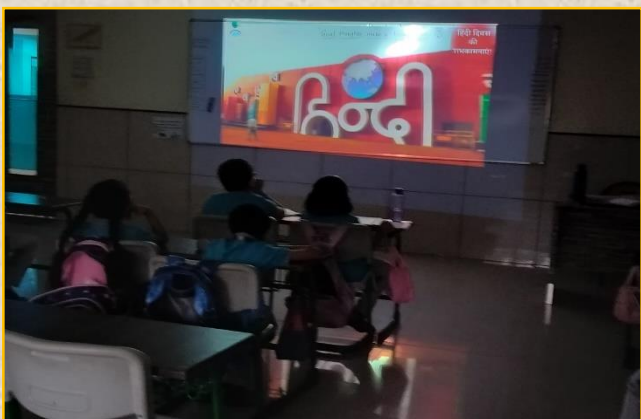
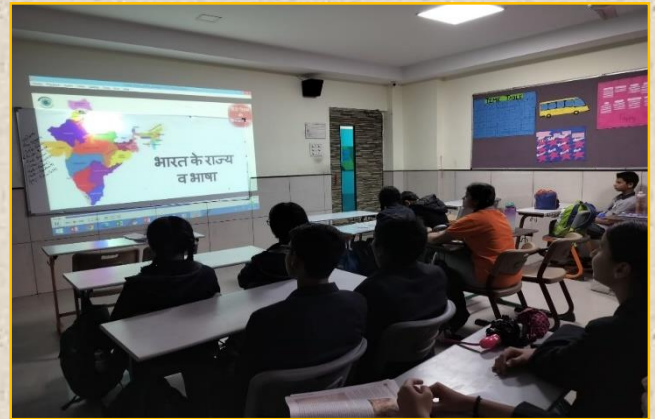
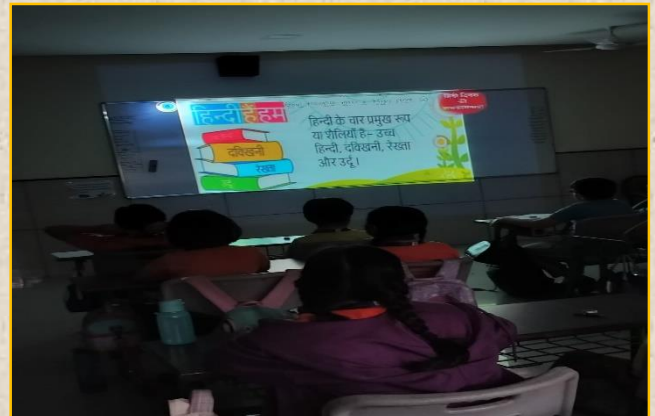


The entire day was a perfect blend of fun, gratitude, and celebration, leaving the teachers with cherished memories and a deep sense of appreciation.

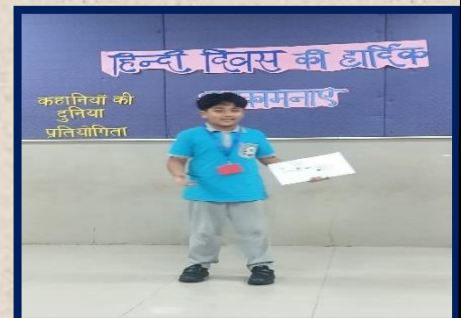




# ‘Kahaniyon ki Duniya’ Competition

*Competitions ignite the spirit of excellence, encouraging students to learn, grow, and shine beyond the classroom.*

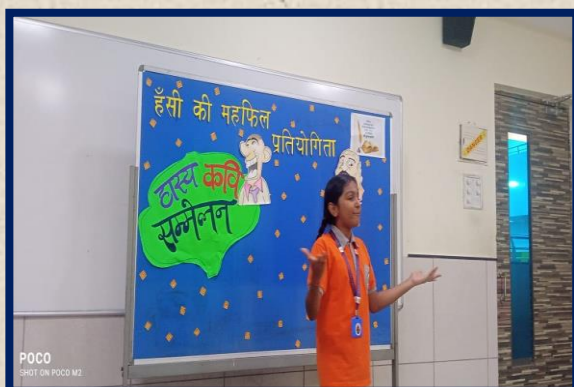

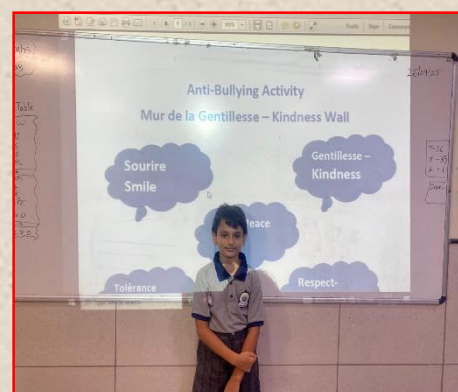
