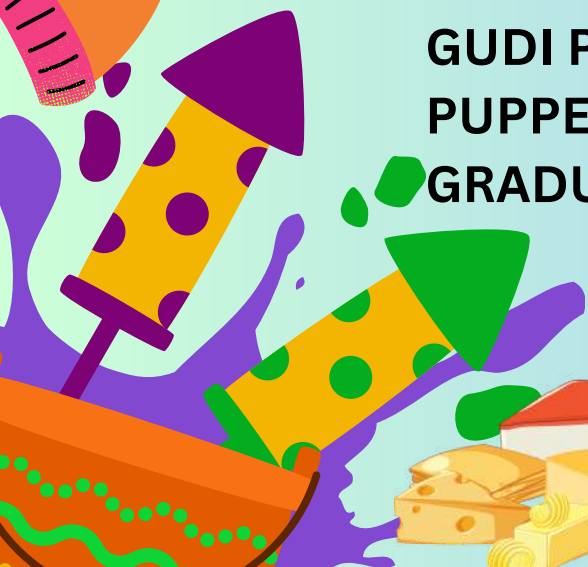

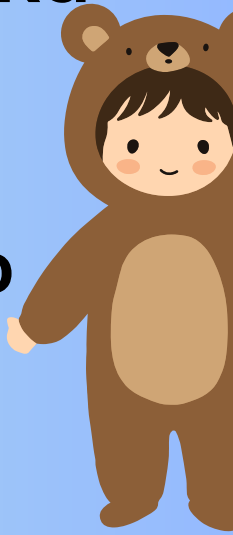

The young learners thoroughly enjoyed the performances and were able to observe and appreciate the cultural aspects in an engaging manner.

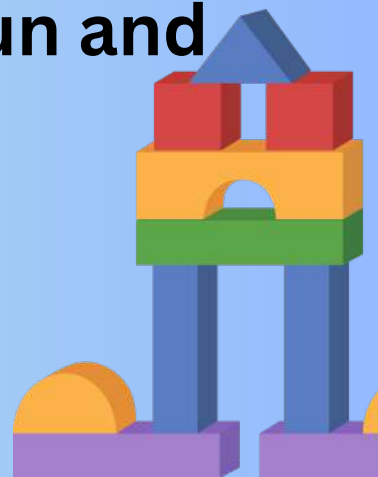
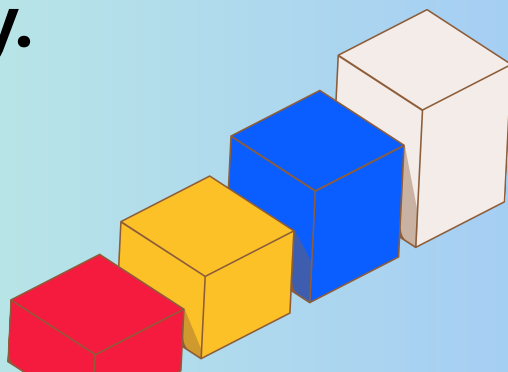

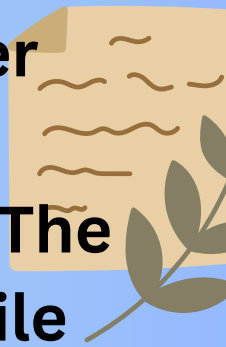






POEM RECITATION

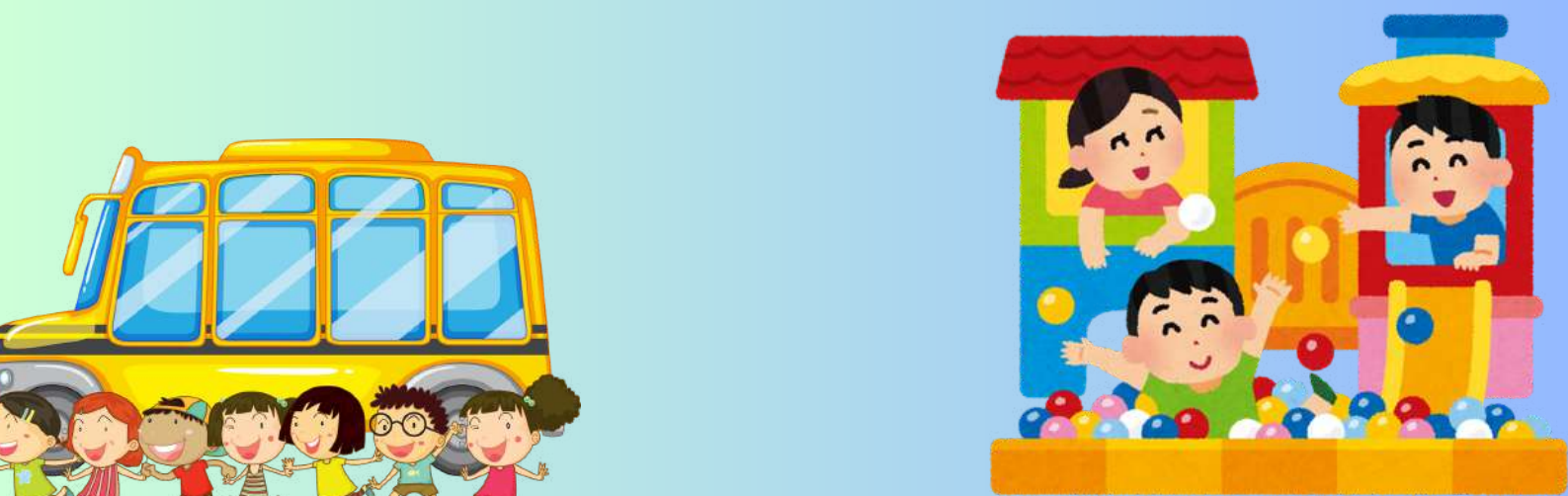
PICNIC - XENOS PLAY AREA

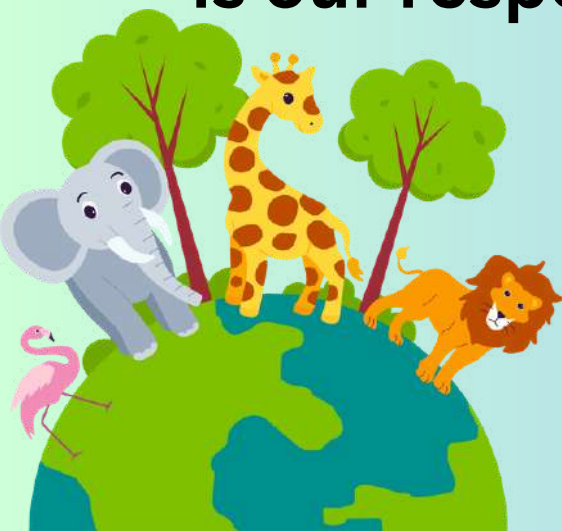


WORLD WILDLIFE DAY

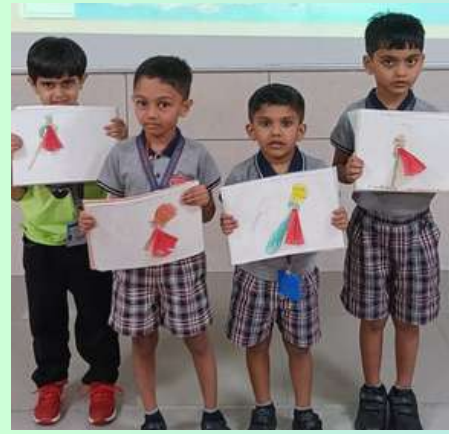
